	To load lowa State student data into Workday, the data was first exported from AccessPlus and other systems in January. Data changes that occurred after that date need to be loaded into the system in a planned data reconciliation phase. This update began on February 26 and is scheduled to continue until September. The final data will be exported from legacy systems on August 16.			
	While data loading was completed with 99.56% accuracy, there are known pieces of data that are not fully converted. These data discrepancies are being addressed, with priority for any issues impacting registration or students graduating in fall 2024. To continue the data reconciliation, data snapshots will be exported to Workday during four windows that begin on the following dates: March 29, May 31, July 1 and August 16.
